About the Speaker

Armen Yeganian is presently the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Armenia to Canada appointed by RA President Serzh Sargsyan in May, 2011. He spent over 15 years in Armenian Government foreign affairs service. Beginning in 1995, he was the Attaché in the Consular Department of the RA Ministry of Foreign Affairs. From 1996 to 1997, he had the position of Third Secretary at the Embassy of the Republic of Armenia to the Russian Federation, Moscow. In 1997, he moved to the United States to assume the position of Third Secretary in the Embassy of the Republic of Armenia to the United States of America, Washington, D.C. which he held until 2000. He returned back to Armenia in 2000 to assume his duties as First Secretary, Head of Visa Division, in the Consular Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of RA. In 2002 he was promoted to Acting Director of that Consular Department until he returned to the United States in 2003 to accept the position of Counselor at the Embassy of the Republic of Armenia to the United States in Washington, D.C. from 2003 to 2006. Just prior to his appointment as Ambassador, Mr. Yeganian held the position of Director of the Department of the Americas in the RA Ministry of Foreign Affairs since 2007. He holds degrees in History from both Leningrad State University in 1987 and Yerevan State University in 1992.
