### **Registration/Building a Schedule**

**First**, schedule required courses in your major

**Second**, schedule Gen Ed Foundation courses

**Third**, schedule Gen Ed Breadth courses

**Finally**, schedule free electives

When planning your Gen Ed courses, be prepared with second and even third-choice courses, in case your first choice course isn't available.

**Class Capacity** is based on pedagogical considerations and will **not** be increased, except in extraordinary cases (e.g., students returning from military service). Instructors are **not** authorized to approve capacity changes, so do not ask them. If a class is full, put your name on the **Wish List** and you will be notified if/when space opens.

### **The Add/Drop period**

You may drop a class during the Add/Drop period. Be sure to have a plan for replacing a dropped course or for making it up later. **Talk to an advisor before dropping a class.**

Adding a class is not guaranteed and is dependent on available seats.
